

EDOW – EDOJ Pilgrimage and Education Tour Registration Form

Dates – Depart 8 December 2010 and Return 20 December 2010

ITINERARY is a separate attachment and I will send it to you as many times as you like – It covers Jordan, Palestine and Israel.

IF YOU ARE NOT AN AMERICAN CITIZEN OR DO NOT HOLD AN AMERICAN PASSPORT FOR OTHER REASONS, PLEASE BE SURE I KNOW THAT!!!!!!

VISA – for *American* Passport holders a VISA is required to get into Jordan but not Israel. You can mail your passport to the Embassy of the Hashemite Kingdom of Jordan or you can drop it off and pick it up at the Embassy. You will need a passport size photo with your application. *Sierra Leone* passport holders: you will need a visa to enter **Israel** and other documents – let us know what you will need from the Diocese.

Everyone, go to the Embassy of Jordan webpage and go to the Consular Section and select the form for the appropriate country. There is a fee. There is parking on the streets near the Embassy (there is a cluster of embassies) and naturally Jordan is at the top of the hill. It is still a nice walk. The Embassy of Israel is in that

same cluster of Embassies. Go to their web page Consular section for more information.

FINANCIALS – The cost for Air Fare and Land Fares, exclusive of personal items such as laundry, extra bottled water and souvenirs:

A \$300 deposit check made out to EDOW and noted for EDOJ Trip 2010 is due to reserve your space and will be taken on a first come, first served basis. You do not have a reservation until we have your deposit; Deadline for the deposit is 24 August 2010.

Final balance is due 15 October, 2010 so that we can meet our deposit deadlines.

If you wish to use a credit card please let me know and we will make those arrangements.

If you have to cancel for any reason before 1 November and we can fill your space, we can refund your money, minus the \$300.00 deposit.

Please consider **travel insurance**.

Please check with your **HEALTH INSURANCE** provider about what you will need to do if you need medical while traveling.

TRAVEL ARRANGEMENTS – If you wish to travel to the Holy Land or wish to leave the group from another route, please let me know. I will tell you what we need to do for you and what you will need to do for yourself. If you do not arrive on the group flight, you will need to arrive at a similar time or make your way to the hotel in Amman. If you need extraordinary pick up from somewhere, there is a \$100.00 charge.

Depending on what your travel changes are, there may be a change in your total costs. Please let me know first if you wish to use other travel arrangements.

OTHER PRACTICAL MATTERS

While everyone can have an off day or two, in general you should be able to walk a mile a day and do steps. As you will see from the itinerary we will be quite active. This is NOT a leisurely tour. Making a pilgrimage plus education program is a busy time. The one thing I can guarantee is that you will not starve. The hospitality is incredible. But approach this as a desire on your part for adventure.

Your **Passport**, whatever the country of issue, must be **valid** until at least 20 June 2011. This is to cover emergency extensions and is pretty much standard practice around the world.

We will have an **orientation meeting** in the fall so that we can meet each other, resolve any rooming issues and go over information we will need for packing etc. Before that I will canvas the group for questions and hopefully have the answers ready.

You will note in the registration form the request for your **passport information**. This is required by the airline and also by our tour guide: a manifest with this information on it will get us through check points faster. Much faster. If you are not comfortable with giving such information through cyberspace, arrange a phone call or meeting time with me to give me that information. It will be then stored on my personal computer in Church House until we leave and then a copy will be given to the Diocese for safekeeping while we travel.
