Sunday Organist

St. Dunstan's Episcopal Church in Bethesda, Maryland is seeking a qualified and committed part-time Organist. St. Dunstan's enjoys a rich tradition of music and arts as an integral part of our worship. Services include a wide range of music, from Hildegard to Moses Hogan.

The organ was built in 1984 by Wicks Organ Company, opus 5957. We also have two full sized grand pianos.

Salary is \$13,000 per annum, plus additional compensation for extraordinary services (e.g., Holy Week, Christmas, funerals, weddings).

Specific duties and responsibilities:

- Serve as organist for Sunday service at 10:30 a.m. (both in person and live-streamed)
- Demonstrate proficiency on the organ and piano for all liturgies through accompaniment, repertoire, and improvisation
- Provide prelude and postlude music
- Rehearse with the professional Cantor and any guest musicians one hour prior to the service
- Provide accompaniment to our Community Children's Choir occasionally throughout the year

Qualifications and skills:

- Bachelor's Degree in music in organ, organ/piano
- Minimum of one year experience as a Church musician
- Excellent sight-reading skills
- Ability to interact and collaborate with all staff in a professional and courteous manner

- Links or files of recordings of your playing, including a Bach Prelude and Fugue and one contemporary piece
